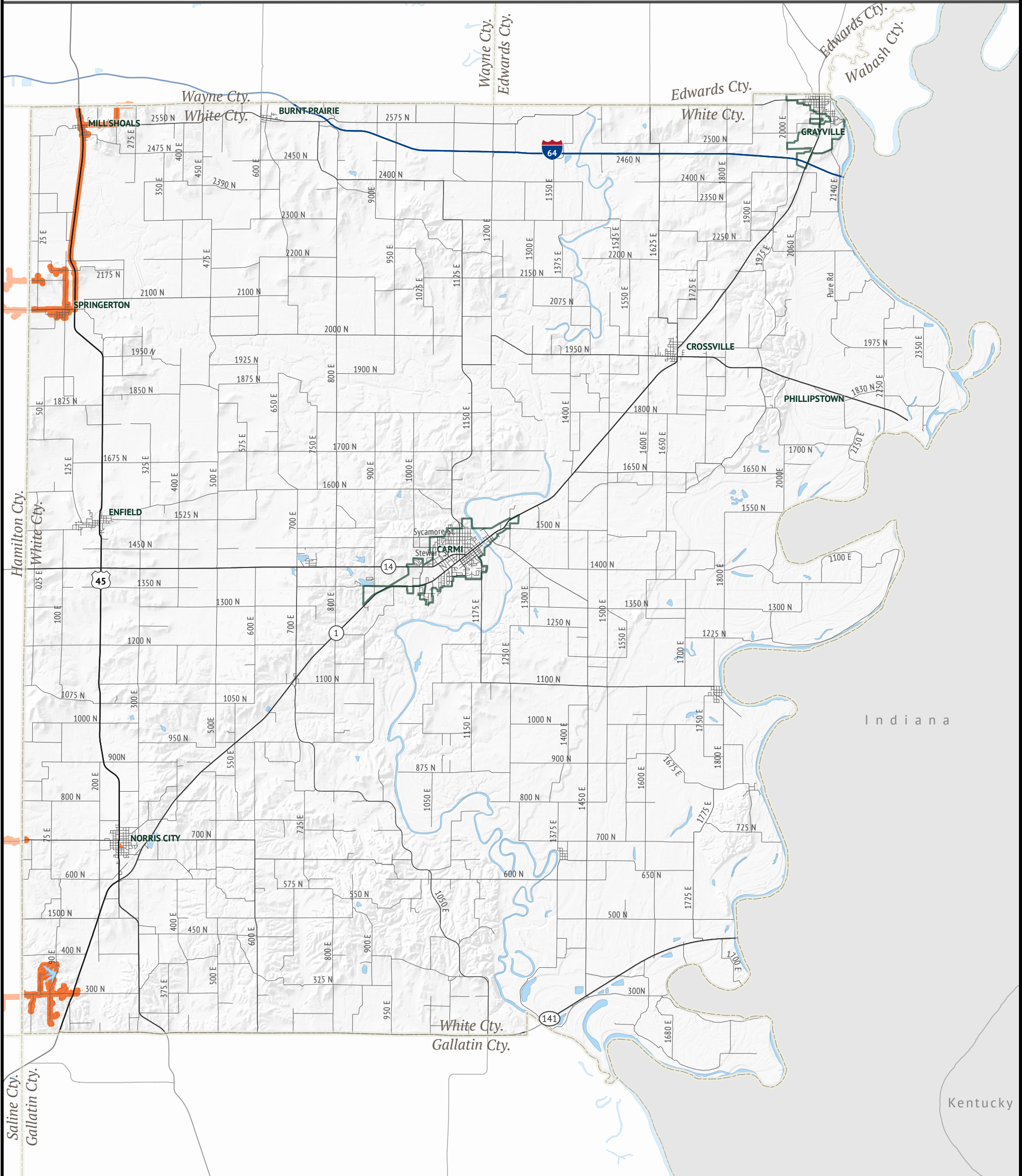



Broadband data are developed from a combination of direct provider outreach and data collection, FCC Form 477 broadband deployment filings, verified consumer broadband feedback, and independent research conducted by Connected Nation. If a broadband provider was unwilling or unable to supply granular data and a detailed service area could not be developed, the provider service availability is represented by FCC Form 477 data, a format which tends to be overstated.

This map is not a guarantee of internet service availability. Mobile and satellite services may also be available.

The current FCC definition of broadband is a minimum speed of 25 Mbps (Megabits per second) download and 3 Mbps upload.
